THE PURPOSE OF CONFRIMATION

- To affirm the baptism and the promises received in Baptism that are most often given as children in an effort to raise up the children in the Christian faith as disciples of Jesus Christ.
- To develop a basic knowledge of the Christian faith and Scripture.

HOW DOES CONFIRMATION WORK?

At St. John's Lutheran Church, we have a three year cycle which covers the Old Testament, The New Testament, and the Small Catechism which will run from September until May each year. Confirmation will always be on the third Sunday in May. Classes are held throughout this time from 4pm to 5:30 pm. If students do run late to class we may go later than that time, but will not run any later than 6:00 PM.

In prior years the expectation would be that each student would attend Confirmation Camp once in their three year journey. This is still encouraged, but will not be an expectation. A camp experience would allow for deeper study and reflection on the faith and Luther's Small Catechism. Our focus is that this be a family faith building time. There will be reviews of the entire class to go over as a family at achurchratedclass.org which will allow for further study, conversation, and reflection for the family. Each student will be expected to be in worship no less than twice each month throughout their three years of study and to be prepared to discuss the Read and Discuss Section in their workbook each week as well as a prepared prayer to share with the class.

At the end of three years, each student will be assessed for preparedness for Confirmation and will present a special project to the class that they will then be prepared to share with the congregation.

EXPECTATIONS

Throughout Confirmations Students are:

- 1) To be present in class both physically and mentally.
- 2) To be respectful of the church property, staff, and fellow classmates.
- 3) To be prepared for the questions in class and ready to discuss.
- 4) To be regularly in worship a minimum of twice per month and ready to serve as acolyte periodically a sign up will be provided.
- 5) To be regularly meeting with their mentors to discuss faith and confirmation, as well as to be going over Scriptures that will be given in class.
- 6) To show a desire to be confirmed and willingness to express their faith in Jesus Christ openly and honestly.

ABOUT MENTORS

Mentors are going to be more vital as we continue to develop our Confirmation Program. A mentor is to be a member of St. John's Lutheran Church and actively attending worship services. A mentor should not be a close relative. A mentor is one who will help in the faith development throughout Confirmation and may be a lifelong person of faith on which the student may come and ask questions openly about faith.
